Mendine Pharmaceuticals: Integrating Forecasting and Production Planning (A)

2 April 2018 was a typically hot and humid summer day in Kolkata. Mr. Srijit Mitra, the Operations Head of Mendine Pharmaceuticals (a pharmaceuticals trading company), was going through an email memo from Mr. Probhas Bondhu Chakraborty, the Chairman and Managing Director. Mr. Mitra had just joined the company as Operations Head in March 2018 after completing his MBA from a reputed business school in the country. The memo summarised the company's performance over the previous years and detailed the expectations for the new financial year FY 2018-19.
