INTRODUCTION

Change management is an important career inflexion point that often determines the shift to the leadership trajectory. Successful change management is arguably the holy grail of leadership. Leading and managing change requires a deep dive into one's own reserves of clarity, keeping the troops motivated despite setbacks, and chart a path that facilitates others' journey to the destination. The aforesaid three areas are built upon individual, interpersonal and organizational understanding that are intertwined to the extent that one is often left perplexed. Clarity of thought, process and action are often elusive.

OBJECTIVES:

The programme aims to equip executives with the knowledge and skills needed to lead successful organizational change initiatives. This programme addresses some of the challenges that leaders/managers face in the wake of dealing with organizational change through multiple perspectives of stakeholders such as:

- Those who design the change,
- Those who carry out the change, and
- The subjects of change

The programme would facilitate:

- Understanding stakeholders
- Finding the core problem to solve through change effort
- Better understanding of leader's own style and source of strengths
- Handling interpersonal situations in a dynamic environment

- · Executing Change: Building and leading change teams
- Stakeholder engagement and influencing: Persuasion and influence, finding courage and clarity amidst chaos
- Institutionalizing new practices: Leader's role in fostering a culture of continuous improvement



PEDAGOGY

This programme will be delivered through a mix of readings, case studies, group discussions, in-class exercises, and simulations. Participants will be encouraged to share their change management experience and facilitate learning from each other.



WHO MAY ATTEND

The programme is designed for people with some experience, preferably those in the middle to senior management cadre. Entrepreneurs or family business owners, second generation business owners (with reasonable experience) are also welcome. The course material will cover a variety of contexts suitable for private sector, public sector, government and not for profit organizations.



PROGRAMME DIRECTORS

Prof. Abhishek Goel (Fellow-IIMA) is a faculty in the Organizational Behavior Group of IIM Calcutta since 2008. He teaches/co-teaches courses across the MBA, MBAEx and Doctoral Programmes.

His publications have appeared in reputed journals including the Harvard Business Review and International Journal of Manpower. He has been a visiting fellow to Germany and Spain. He has won research based awards, including the Young Scientist Scholarship at the 29th International Congress of Psychology in Berlin. His course on Global Leadership for CEMS (www.cems.org) won the Best Course of the Year Award in 2023. He has been the President of the International Society for the Study of Work and Organizational Values (ISSWOV, www.issowv.net) from 2018-2022.

Prof. Rajiv Kumar has earned his Ph.D. from IIM Ahmedabad. He has worked for about 5 years across an NGO (Society for Promotion of Wastelands Development), an international HR consulting firm (Hewitt Associates) and academia (IMT Ghaziabad) before joining IIM Calcutta in March, 2008.

His current research interests include cross-cultural issues, organizational citizenship behaviors, and construct specification. His research has appeared in peer-reviewed outlets such as journals, edited books, and conference proceedings. He teaches compulsory and elective courses in the doctoral, MBA, and other full-time programmes of IIM Calcutta. He also engages with industry through executive education and consulting.

Prof. Vidyanand Jha has been teaching in the Organizational Behaviour Group of IIM Calcutta since 1997. He has offered multiple Management Development Programmes on Communication and Presentation Skills over the years. These programmes are known for their participant centred learning.
